How to Enter an Exhibit

1. Get an exhibitor number by going to
<https://www.assistexpo.ca/vanscoy-district-ag-society>
2. Gather up your items you want to enter
3. Fill out the entry tags (pick up at school or local businesses)
4. Fill out entry form (you can find online at vanscoyag.com)
5. Bring items to Delisle Community Center (former Senior Center) on
Sept 11th 5:00–7:30pm

Receiving Entries – an example of a completed entry tag.

How to fill out an Entry Tag:

- ~ Class is the category you are entering.
- ~ Section is the item within the class.
- ~ Article is the name of the item.
- ~ Variety is the name of the Article – example for Class 4 Section 2
Article 59, the name is Animal - Pet.
- ~ Exhibitors No. Each exhibitor will be assigned a unique identification
number.
- ~ Name
- ~ Address, please put the town you live in.

3. **String, wire or hook required for hanging.**
Entries not meeting these criteria will be disqualified.
4. One entry per person per article.

2. **Must be mounted for hanging or they will be disqualified**
3. May be commercially processed, but must be taken by exhibitor in 2025/2026
4. Can be digital – must not be altered
5. **String, wire or hook required for hanging**
6. Mounted materials may include (Bristol board, construction paper, cardstock, frame) suitable for attaching/hanging on display boards
7. Cannot repeat the same picture/photo in multiple categories
8. One entry per person per article

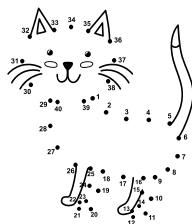

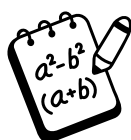

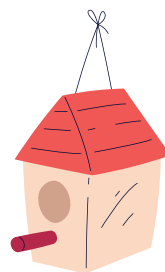
